# 1. JOB TITLE: VACCINATION NURSE (7 POSITIONS)

### **POSITION SUMMARY**

The Vaccination Nurse will be responsible for managing COVID-19 vaccinations, vaccine administration, tracking and reporting adverse reactions and providing patient care at vaccination sites and during community events. She/he will take the overall supervision and running of the vaccination at the mobile clinics, this includes managing vaccine stock in the mobile clinics, patient registration for COVID-19 vaccine, ordering of relevant supplies, adherence to policies and procedures, compliance with infection control principles and safe vaccine management and use. He/She will participate in community events, campaigns and other demand creation activities
