- Plan for spares and sub-assemblies to ensure timely availability. Monitor the stocks and Initiate procurement action in consultation with HOD for timely replenishment.
- Contribute positively in all major shutdown activities from preparatory phase.
- Ensure that all work is done through ODOO ERP system and maintenance work orders are completed.
- Participate actively in skill development activities like On-the Job Training (OJT).
